## Unit 7 Sample Dialogue 1

Find a partner in your class. Together, each partner will act out each role in the sample below. Then, create your own dialogue. Use the verb chart that you made in Lesson 5.

## Sample:

· Role: Teacher

Situation- You are meeting a new student for the first time. You have to teach him/her ten new verbs before class begins. Introduce yourself and then teach your student the verbs by showing what each means and by making sure your student understands.

Role: Student

Situation- You are meeting your new English teacher for the first time. Before class begins, you need to learn ten new verbs. Introduce yourself to your teacher and tell him/her where you are from. You will need to show you know what each verb means.

- A: Hello, my name is Ms. Garcia. Please sit down. What is your name?
- B: My name <u>is</u> Mario. I <u>am</u> nervous about school.
- A: I <u>understand</u>, but don't <u>be</u> scared. I <u>am going to help</u> you. Is this "swim?" (show jump)
- B: No, that's "jump."
- A: This is "swim."
- B: Swim.
- A: I read, write, and talk in English class.
- B: You read, write, talk, and teach in English class.
- A: I teach and you learn.
- B: You <u>are</u> my teacher. I <u>learn</u> from you.
- A: Stand up, point down, and touch the chair.
- B: Stand up, point right, and touch the paper.
