## Unit 9 Sample Dialogue 1

Work in groups of 3 to create a role-play involving an exchange of money. Each person should have at least 4 sentences to say. The role-play should have a greeting, involve an exchange of a good or service, an amount for cost, a payment, some change and a closing remark (goodbye). Suggestions: Shopping for the best price for CDs and then buying, shopping for the best price for shoes and then buying, shopping for a selection of favorite foods, having a limited amount of money to spend in the cafeteria for lunch. Read through the sample dialogue below with your partners before creating your own.

Sample:

A: Hi Lei, what's up? How are you doing today?

- B: I'm hungry. Is it time for lunch yet?
- C: I think we still have 10 minutes before the bell rings.
- A: What do you feel like eating?
- B: Anything. I want a sandwich, chips and some juice.
- C: How much will all that cost? Do you have enough money?
- B: I have \$6.00. Why? How much does all that cost?
- A: The sandwich costs \$2.45, the chips cost \$1.00 and the price of the juice is \$1.25.
- C: Hey, that's only \$4.70. Will you buy me a bag of chips? I'll pay you back tomorrow.
- A: Hey, me too, I want some juice.
- B: Let me add this up, \$4.70, \$1.00 + \$1.25 = that's\$6.95. Sorry, one of you will have to pay for your own.
- C: That's okay, I'm not that hungry. I don't need the chips. You guys go buy it. I'll see you later.
