Prepositions

Prepositions are words that help us understand time, place and direction.

- <u>At</u> is a preposition of time and place. I go home **at** eight o'clock. Tony works **at** a sandwich shop.
- <u>Next to</u> is a preposition of place. It indicates proximity. Michael sits next to Luis.
- <u>In front of</u> is also a preposition of place and indicates frontal proximity. The post office is **in front of** the bank.
- <u>Behind</u> is a preposition of place and indicates rear proximity. The parking lot is **behind** the store.
- Between is a preposition of place and means "in the middle of." Eva sat between two people.
- <u>Through</u> is a preposition of direction and indicates going from one end to the other. Tony drove **through** the tunnel.
- <u>On</u> is a preposition of place and indicates above or in a specific place. That store is **on** Main Street.


